After schools programs: Information regarding after school programs is given by the school your child has been given a school place, contact the school you're applying to for more information.

References to sibling priority placement: The placement procedure for admission to municipal schools state that sibling placements are prioritized for children applying to kindergarten programs. The older sibling must be attending classes K-3 in the following school year in the school applied to, and have a registered address which is the same as the younger sibling, and should live no more than 2 kilometers from the school to which they are applying. This registered address applies whether the siblings are biological siblings or not. Free schools have their own admission procedures. Contact the free school you are applying to for more information.

Needs that gives priority placement to certain schools (municipality elementary schools)

All students have the right to support in school. This support can be according to the student's needs and circumstances, and should take place primarily in the group or class the student attends. All schools have the responsibility for providing this support and it should not influence a student's application to any particular school.

The possibility exists to exercise this right for priority placement in cases of special needs for pedagogical or social reasons. If you wish to exercise this right for your child according to this rule you must send in a supplemental letter that describes the need.

Send the supplement letter directly to the school you're applying to in connection with the application.

Admission to certain schools will require the signature of both guardians.

The decision of school placement is covered in the school law 10 kap. 30 § st. 1 or 9 kap. 15 § st which states that a child should be placed in a school which the guardians approve. **The desired placement** should not displace another child's right to be placed near home, **however all children are guaranteed a place in a school 2, 3, or 4 kilometers from home depending on the grade attending.** If the demand for places is higher than the number of available places, the Department of Education will apply the rule of proximity.
